ANNUAL FSR	No (FSR due at end of competing segment)
APPLICATION USED	<b>Competing:</b> SF 424 <b>Non-Competing:</b> PHS 2590
ELIGIBLE COSTS	<b>Limited to \$300,000 direct costs per year</b> (excluding 3 <sup>rd</sup> party F&A)  <b>Generally all PAR's include</b> but are not limited to: Personnel, Supplies, Consultants, Equipment, Travel, 3 <sup>rd</sup> Party, Other Expenses and Student costs (Compensation, Subsistence Allowance (meals/lodging/etc.), tuition, and travel).  <b>PAR-06-540</b> contains a more exhaustive list of eligible costs and it contains specific language about administrative/clerical costs not normally provided by the applicant organization. PAR-06-540 costs to support full-time participants are not allowable.
ELIGIBILITY	Public and private, non-profit or for-profit organizations in the US, its possessions or territories. Foreign institutions are not eligible. <b>Most eligibility questions will be referred to NCI program director.</b>
EX.AUTH. & FDP	Yes
FACILITIES AND ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS	8% of modified total direct costs, exclusive of tuition and fees, expenditures for equipment and sub-grants/contracts in excess of \$25,000; 3 <sup>rd</sup> party F&A costs at 8% modified total direct costs.
JUST-IN-TIME	Yes - Beginning with PAR-06-540
MODULAR	No
ORI ASSURANCE	No – not required if institution doesn't have one.
PERIOD OF SUPPORT	Up to 5 years – short-term studies limited to five years or less.
PROGRAM INCOME	Additional Cost Alternative
PURPOSE OF GRANT	Curriculum-driven program to develop and sustain innovative educational approaches that will have in impact on reducing cancer incidence, mortality and morbidity, as well as improving the quality of life of cancer patients. Can include short courses, national forums, seminars and/or hands-on workshops; design, development and evaluation of new curricula of special significance to cancer in educational institutions; structured short-term didactic and research experiences; development and evaluation of new educational methods and tools; and, symposia and support of rapidly evolving areas.
RENEWABLE (T2)	Varies in each PAR – Grantee should be advised to contact NCI Program Director
SALARY/ STIPEND RANGE	Not to exceed Executive Level I of the Federal Executive pay scale. NRSA levels are not applicable.
SNAP	YES – NOTE: Subject to change
SPECIAL FEATURES	Evaluation Plan Dissemination Plan Institutional Commitment (strongly encouraged)
STATUS OF PERSONNEL	Personnel should be employees of the grantee institution, but programs may vary widely. All appropriate NCI/NIH requirements must be met for all individuals receiving compensation from these awards.
TRANSFER	Yes but because of the unique nature of this program the NCI Program Director should be contacted prior to submission of transfer application.
